The Center For Family Services SERV program needs dedicated and caring volunteers to respond to hospitals and police departments to assist victims of domestic violence, sexual violence, and human trafficking in their time of need.

Volunteer Requirements

- 18 years old or older
- Complete a 60-hour in-person/online training
- Commit to monthly on-call responsibility with access to a vehicle
- Dedicate one year of service under the supervision of the Volunteer Supervisor
- Attend a minimum of 6 volunteer meetings/trainings per year
- Provide trauma-informed support that is compassionate, empathetic, and victim-centered

Our next 60-hour in-person training program is scheduled for the following 2020 dates:

January 6th, 8th, 13th, 15th, 22nd, 27th and 29th

February 3rd, 5th, 10th, 12th, and 17th.
